# Ronald Louis Ferguson

**R**onald Louis Ferguson, 73, of Minden, Nevada, and Woodstock, Connecticut, passed away after a brief battle with cancer on Wednesday, January 28, 2026. He leaves behind a life defined by strength, humor, and steadfast love.

To know Ronald—whether as Ron, Ronnie, or Fergie—was to know true loyalty. He showed up, he listened, and he cared deeply about the people and projects he was involved with. He valued honesty, hard work, and his close relationships; those who loved him knew they could always count on him without question.

Ron was born on December 6, 1952, in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, to Louis Ferguson and Betty Schmidt, both of whom preceded him in death. 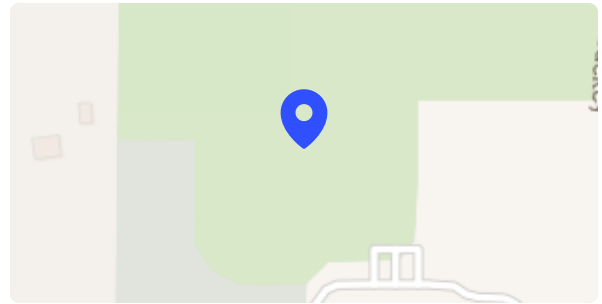
